### Contact Seminar: *Tackling early school leaving*

**Málaga (Spain): 13<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> December 2015**

**Early school leaving** is linked to unemployment, social exclusion, and poverty. There are many reasons why some young people give up education and training prematurely: personal or family problems, learning difficulties, or a fragile socio-economic situation. The way the education system is set up and the environment in individual schools are also important factors.

Since there is not a single reason for early school leaving, there are no easy answers. The role of schools in developing innovative and motivating methodologies is crucial. The policy to reduce early school leaving must address a range of triggers and combine education and social issues, youth work and others.

The **Erasmus+ Programme** shall contribute to the achievement of the objectives of the Europe 2020 Strategy, including the headline education target which is to reduce early school leaving to less than 10% and increase attainment in tertiary education to at least 40% by 2020. Thereby reducing early school leaving is one of the priorities of the Programme.

### WHAT IS A CONTACT SEMINAR?

A contact seminar is a networking event organized by a National Agency in collaboration with other National Agencies as a Transnational Cooperation Activity (TCA). It aims at bringing together people from organizations which share common interests and would like to develop European cooperation projects/partnerships in the field of education and vocational training. It is a great “partner-finding” opportunity that will also allow to:

- Receive more information on the Erasmus+ Programme and the sector of interest;
- Receive information on good practice examples and meet people from organizations which have already developed European cooperation projects;
- Get to know suitable partner organizations;
