International credit mobility

- International opening of Erasmus
135,000 grants in 7 years
- For students & staff (for learning & teaching)
- Action managed by **National Agencies located in Europe**
- Use of Erasmus Quality Framework



Student credit mobility



- All levels (short cycle, Bachelor, Master, PhD) + recent graduates + all disciplines
- 3 to 12 months for studies
- 2 to 12 months for traineeships
(from 2016 for partner countries)
- Up to 12 months per study cycle
- For **staff** – from 5 days to 2 months



Erasmus quality framework

- **Erasmus Charter** for Higher Education – for Partner countries, the principles of the Charter are embedded in the inter-institutional agreements
- **Inter-institutional agreements** to set mobility flows & preconditions- signed before mobilities start
- **Learning Agreement** for students

- Non discrimination
- Full recognition
- No fees charged
- Publish course catalogues
- Good preparation of mobile students (language, documents, logistics)
- Assistance for visas, accommodation, insurance
- Guidance to incoming participants
- Equal academic treatment & services
- Integration into the local society
- Mentoring
- Linguistic support



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Erasmus+

- Higher competition than for intra-EU mobility
- Budgets allocated to Nat Agencies per region
 - 1. Neighbourhood 47%
 - 2. Western Balkans 18%
 - 3. Asia 18%
 - 4. Industrialised countries 9%
 - 5. Latin America 5%
- Additional selection criteria for countries with small budgets

- ✓ Grants between €650 and €850 + travel costs
- ✓ 16 or 24 months to organise the mobilities
- ✓ **European universities** apply on behalf of the partnership (to their NA) individually or within a consortium for:
 - Mobility to/from Partner countries
 - Individually or within a consortium (only between 2 countries)
